Resolutions due Feb. 1st

Your opportunity to influence policy

February 1 is the deadline to submit a resolution for consideration by the 2018 WMS House of Delegates.

Guidelines for drafting resolutions include:

- Select a title that appropriately reflects the action the resolution seeks;
- Carefully check the resolution for accuracy;
- The wording of the "Resolved" statement must be able to stand alone as an item to be acted upon by the HOD. Only the "Resolved" language is considered for adoption;
- Resolutions should include reference to existing policy as relevant, or a statement that no Society policy currently exists on the topic.
