Opioid Prescribing CME

Dec. 31 is deadline to complete MEB-required course

Just a few days remain before the deadline to complete an approved two-hour CME program on responsible opioid prescribing.

In 2016, the Wisconsin Medical Examining Board (MEB) approved a rule requiring physicians with a DEA number to complete two CME credits on its opioid prescribing guideline during the current CME cycle, as well as two credits in the next cycle-Jan. 1, 2018 to Dec. 31, 2019.
